INTRODUCTION: Jonah is more famous now than he was then – John 7:52

1:1 – God has something to say to YOU – Jeremiah 33:3,
Isaiah 55:11

1:2 – 3 COMMANDS:

1.- ***“Arise”*** – Jonah was *“comfortable”* where he was.
- God calls the *“comfortable”* to WAKE UP – Romans 13:11,
Mark 13:35-36

- God wants us to get out of our *“comfort zone”*.

1 We Get Too Comfortable In Our CHRISTIAN LIFE

- The tendency is to forget God when things go well.
- We think God’s blessing because we deserve it – Lk. 18:22

1 We Get Too Comfortable In Our WORSHIP

- Are we *“uncomfortable”* with ... CONVICTION ...
REPENTANCE ... SURRENDER?

2 We Get Too Comfortable In Our PRAYER LIFE

- We ought to *“pour out”* our hearts to God – Psalm 62:8

3 We Get Too Comfortable In Our CHURCH

- Church is an opportunity to minister, serve, worship.

2.- “go to Nineveh”

- God doesn’t tell us to do the EASY thing.
- If it were EASY, we wouldn’t depend on Him.
- God calls you to do more than you can handle ... *“I can’t!”*
- God wants us to rely on Him – Philippians 2:13, 4:13
- God calls you to go outside your *“comfort zone”*.

3.- “cry out against it”

- The truth often CONVICTS.
- Sin can’t be hidden, or over-looked by God.
