

“I’ve Got A Secret?” – Psalm 139:1-12

INTRODUCTION: There are no “secrets” from God – **139:4**

- “*Jesus is the Lord of this house ... the unseen guest at every meal ... the unseen listener to every conversation.*”

- Is God an “eavesdropper”? You can’t escape His “surveillance”.

139:1 – Mt. 10:30 – God knows all about you – John 10:14

- God knows our every problem ... the Master “*Psychiatrist*”.

139:2 – We can’t fool God, like we can other people.

139:3-4 – “*Gossip*” – “*telling someone a story, who is neither part of the problem, nor part of the solution.*”

- What’s intended only for 1 person, gets to God’s ear too!

- God tells us beforehand that He’s going to listen in on us.

- This knowledge is reassuring and supportive ... God knows us personally, and is aware of all our needs – **139:6**

139:7-8 – Even “*death*” doesn’t hide us from God’s presence.

- Only those sins that are “*washed in the blood*” will God not “*see*” – Eccl. 12:14, Luke 12:2, 1 Cor. 4:5

- God’s continual awareness of us is GOOD! **139:9-12**

1.- We Need To EXPERIENCE God’s Presence

1He is our FATHER ... and desires a personal relationship.

2He is our BRIDE-GROOM ... and desires responsive love.

2.- We Need To CONFIDE In Him

1We have SECRETS so others will LIKE us.

- God KNOWS all about you, but LOVES you anyhow!

1We can’t trust others with our SECRETS.

- Psalm 62:8 – “*Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; God is a refuge for us.*”

- We can pour out our heart to God ... He understands.

- You don’t have to explain anything to Him ... He understands.

- God is our “*refuge*” for the “*storms*” that rage within us.

- We can “*anchor*” our hearts in the “*harbor*” of His love and care.

CONCLUSION:

- God is always available, so “*reach out*” to Him.

- God loves you enough to DIE to take your punishment for sin.

- Be HONEST with God.
