

## ***“Poor Little Me!”***

**INTRODUCTION:** Do you ever feel like ... You're not worth much  
Nobody loves you ... You can't do anything right?

- We need to be “*little*” enough for God to use, yet not think “*too little*” of ourselves.
- Many in the Bible had an “*Inferiority Complex*”:

**1.- MOSES – Exodus 3:10** – God calls Moses for ministry.

**3:11** – He's questioning God's ability to select leadership.

**3:12** – God saw this as a training school experience.

**4:1** – Moses has his eyes on HIMSELF.

**4:2-3** – God re-directs Moses' eyes!

- Maybe God needs to bring some “*snakes*” into YOUR life.

**4:4-5, 4:10** – You don't have to be a good speaker for God to use you.

**4:11, 4:12** – God will take full responsibility.

- Give God your inabilities, and He will turn them into abilities.

**2.- JEREMIAH – Jeremiah 1:4-5** – God calls Jeremiah for ministry.

**1:6** – Jeremiah gives the same excuse as Moses did.

- God knows Jeremiah can't do it on his own ... without God.

**1:7-8** – We're afraid of what people will say and think.

**1:9** – God doesn't want “*sermonizers*” ... He wants “*messengers*”.

- God sees you differently than you see yourself – Mt. 6:26, 27-30

- You're worth so much that God sent His Son to DIE for you!

- God's still working on you – Phil. 1:6, 2:13

- We concentrate on the “*unfinished*” part, instead of the “*finished*” part ... we're a “*diamond in the rough*”.

**3.- AMOS – Amos 7:10** – God calls Amos for ministry.

- Amos is a “*Fig-Picker*”, out-of-place in the King's palace.

**7:12** – Amos is told to go preach someplace else.

**7:14-15** – It was God's idea to call Amos – Phil. 4:13

- God made you like He wanted you – Jeremiah 1:5

- God doesn't make mistakes.

**CONCLUSION:** You can't feel inferior, without your consent.

- You are SPECIAL to God ... God's “*somebody*”.

- God can use you in spite of your limitations.
