

“When God Has Had Enough”

INTRODUCTION: Ahab was a wicked King – 1 Kings 16:33

- God was angry at King Ahab – **1 Kings 20:13** ... **20:28**
- God had enough! **1 Kings 20:42-43**, Proverbs 29:1
- Sometimes, God says *“That’s enough!”* ... Herod - Acts 12:23,
Judah - 2 Chronicles 36:16

1 Kings 21:1-3 – King Ahab covets Naboth’s vineyard.

- Satan uses sins of *“impulse”* in your life – 1 Peter 5:8
- Will you leave more things behind, than you’ve sent ahead?

21:3 – Naboth couldn’t sell it to King Ahab – Numbers 36:7

21:4 – Covetousness for the things of the world, will ruin your spiritual appetite – 1 Timothy 6:10

21:5-6 – Naboth was wanting to do God’s will.

21:7 – As a Christian, you can’t just do what YOU please.

- Satan’s Kids act like him ... God’s Kids are to act like Him.

21:8-10 – This is being done in the name of *“religion”*.

- Don’t do bad things and hide it under the *“cause of Christianity”*.

21:11-13 – God’s judgment is the only one that really counts.

- Live your life as if 1 day you’ll have to face God.

21:14-16 – Being faithful to God is *“costly”* – Galatians 2:20,

Matthew 16:24-25, Romans 12:1

21:17-19 – Ahab is just as guilty as Jezebel – James 4:17

21:20 – You are Satan’s enemy ... never forget that!

21:21-29 – Ahab was *“sorry”*, but for **WHAT?** 2 Cor. 7:9-10

- Without true repentance, punishment may be delayed, but never pardoned.
